Art, heritage and waterfront evenings, with time to breathe.

Day by Day

Day 1 — Arrival & Souq Scenes

Transfer privately from DOH to your hotel. As lights come on, step into Souq Waqif for textiles, perfumes, and a glimpse of nightly routines. Visit the Falcon Souq to see birds on perches and browse traditional gear. Your guide shares how desert life adapted to the coast's trade winds and dhow traffic. Dinner is at leisure with curated recommendations.

Day 2 — Art & Architecture

Spend a focused morning at MIA, choosing a themed path—calligraphy, metalwork, or carpets—with your guide. Move on to NMoQ, where immersive displays and archival film connect pearling, oil, and present-day design culture. Pause at MIA Park café for skyline photos and breezes from the bay. Afternoon options include Msheireb Museums or a design store loop in Downtown Msheireb. Evening at leisure on the Corniche or The Pearl promenades.

Day 3 — Katara & The Pearl

Explore Katara Cultural Village—galleries, amphitheater, and craft corners—often with pop-up shows or workshops. Continue to The Pearl-Qatar for marina walks, gelato stops, and relaxed shopping. Toward sunset, consider a traditional dhow cruise for skyline photographs from the water. Your guide can arrange a modern Qatari tasting menu for dinner. Return to the hotel at an easy pace.

Day 4 — Departure

Breakfast and a slow morning, then private transfer to DOH. Luggage and timings are double-checked the night before. You'll have assistance at the correct terminal and counters. Safe onward journey with Doha's light still in mind.
